# **MBA Specialization in Healthcare Systems Management**

The MBA program is being modified by the addition of this specialization and the associate concentrations. The required/core courses for the MBA program are not being changed, only this specialization is being added.

The College of Business and Innovation is offering an MBA Specialization in Healthcare Systems Management, which has the following three concentrations.

1. MBA in Health Care System Management with Public Health Administration concentration. The following four courses are required for this concentration. All courses are 3 credit hours.
  - a. PUBH 604 Public Health Administration (offered Fall semester)
  - b. PUBH 621 Management of Public Health Agencies (offered Spring semester)
  - c. PUBH 622 Budget and Finance in Public Health (offered Spring semester)
  - d. PUBH 628 Economics, Marketing, and Human Resources (offered Spring semester)
2. MBA in Health Care System Management with Health Promotion and Education concentration. The following four courses are required for this concentration. All courses are 3 credit hours.
  - a. PUBH 620 Methods and Materials in Public Health (offered Fall semester)
  - b. PUBH 630 Community Health Organizations (offered Spring semester)
  - c. PUBH 646 Health Promotion Programs (offered Fall semester)
  - d. PUBH 680 Evaluation of Health Programs (offered Fall semester)
3. MBA in Health Care System Management with Public Health Administration concentration. The following four courses are required for this concentration. All courses are 3 credit hours. PUBH 601 is required for the concentration and three of the remaining courses are required.
  - a. PUBH 601 Public Health Epidemiology (offered Fall and Spring semesters)
  - b. PUBH 600/800 Public Health Biostatistics (offered Fall and Spring semesters)
  - c. PUBH 612/812 Infectious Disease Epidemiology (offered Fall semester in class)
  - d. PUBH 615/815 Clinical Epidemiology (offered Spring semester in class)
  - e. PUBH 618/818 Cancer Epidemiology (offered Spring semester in class, offered Summer term as a DL course)
  - f. PUBH 655/855 Chronic Disease Epidemiology (offered Summer term in class, offered Fall semester as a DL course)
