We would like to make two changes to our program requirements. One of the required courses for the MA degree is SPSY 7180 Consultation II: School and Home (3) offered summer semester. And SPSY 7190 Consultation III: School and Community offered summer semester is required for the Education Specialist (EdS) degree. Other Course Requirements (must take a minimum of two (2) for the Master's degree) EDP 5210 Child Behavior & Dev (3) or EDP 5/7220 Adolescent Dev or CEIC 6/8750 Early Childhood (3) EDP-5/7320 Instructional Psychology (3) or EDP 5/7110 Basic Educational Psychology (3) COUN 5/7140 Counseling Theories & Techniques (4) SPSY 6/7260 Developmental Child Psychopathology (3) COUN 5/7160 Cultural Diversity for the Counselors & the School Psychologist (3)	We would like to change it so that students may take SPSY 7180 for their MA or they make take SPSY 7190 for their MA. They will still be required to take both classes but instead of stating it must be SPSY 7180 for the MA and SPSY 7190 for the EdS, they may take SPSY 7180 or SPSY 7190 for the MA and then the one they do not take for the MA they will take for the EdS. The content in the classes is not sequential. 7180 focuses on functioning as a system level instructional consultant and 7190 focuses on functioning as a system level mental health consultant. This change is necessary to meet the needs of our students. We would like to change "other course requirements" so that it reads, "must take at least one (1) for the Master's degree." The list of classes would not change and they would still take all of these courses during their program, but may only take one for the MA and the rest of the courses for the EdS. Last year we added a 4-hour prepractica for the MA and as a result, student schedules do not permit taking two of the other course requirements as it pushes them over 15 semester hours for both fall and spring semesters.
