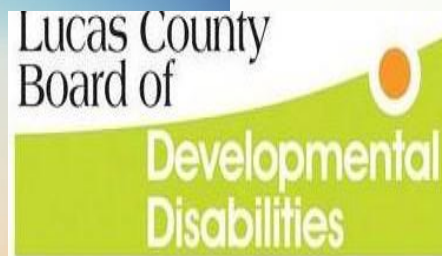

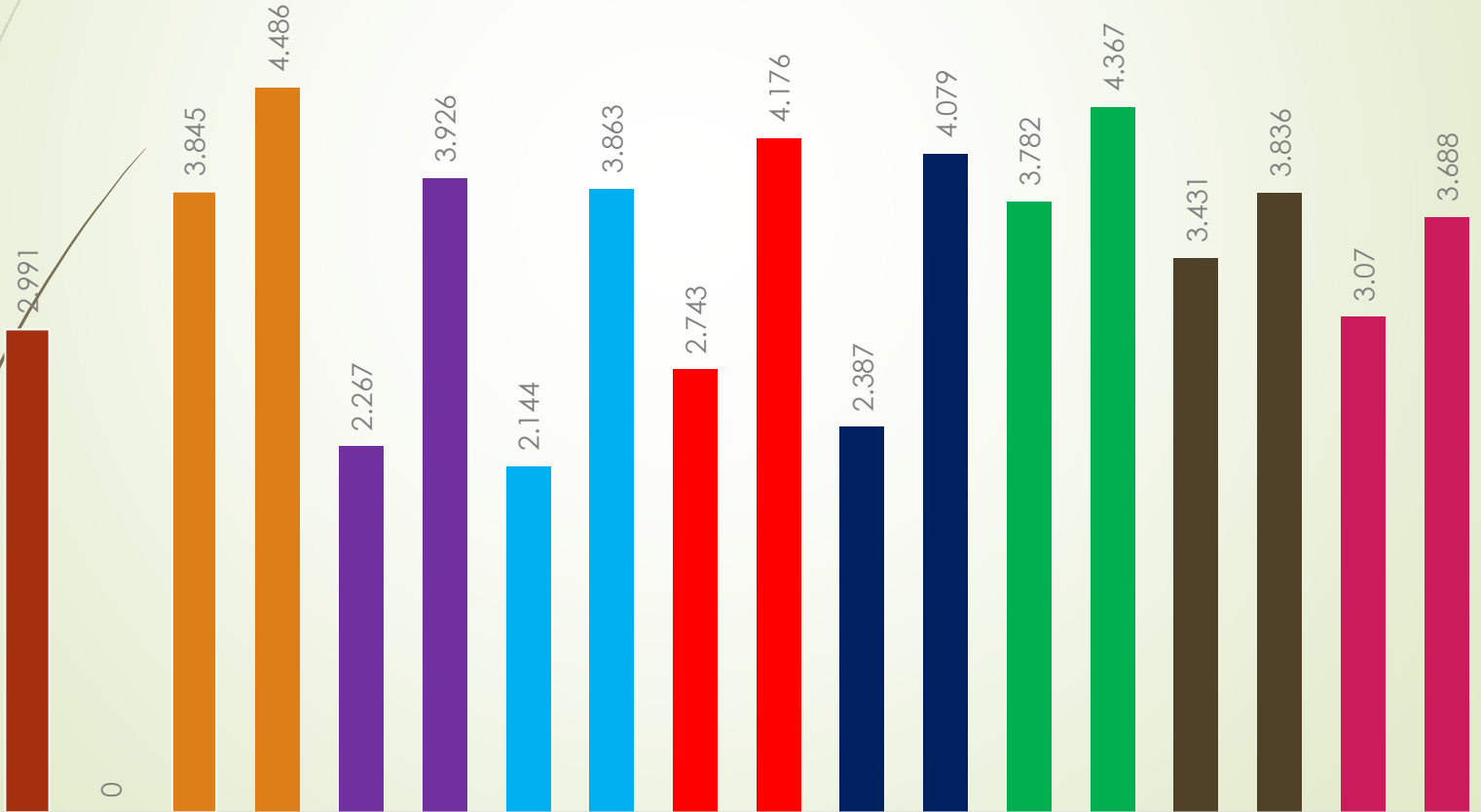

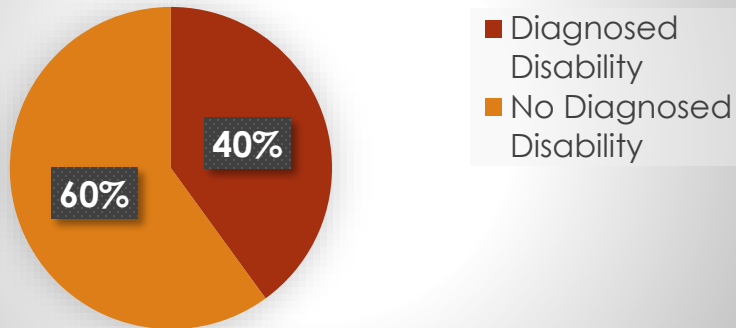
# Clients & Services

- Enrollment started: August 2016
- 12 clients so far!
- About the Clients (based on the first 10 clients)
  - 100% females in poverty
  - 50% sex trafficked, 10% labor trafficked, 40% prostituted
  - Ages: 24-49
  - Race/ethnicity: 60% white; 10% Hispanic; 10% multi-racial; 10% unknown
  - 50% need legal services
  - 60% basic needs
  - 60% transportation

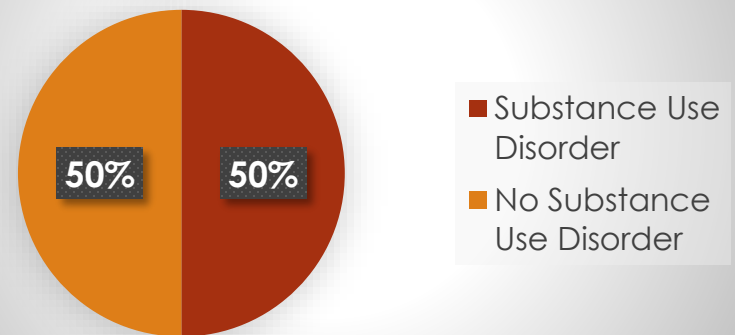

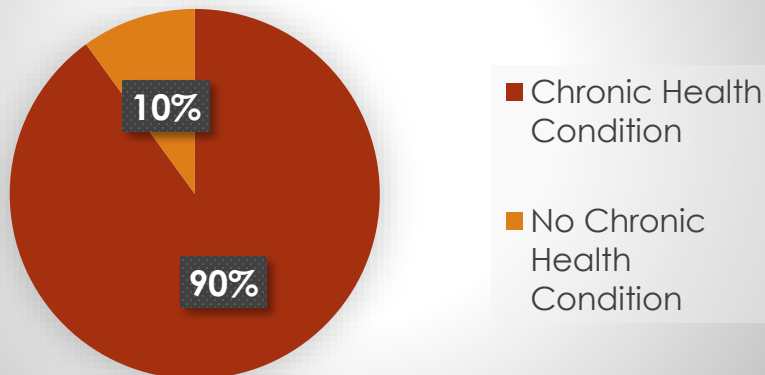
## Diagnosed Disability



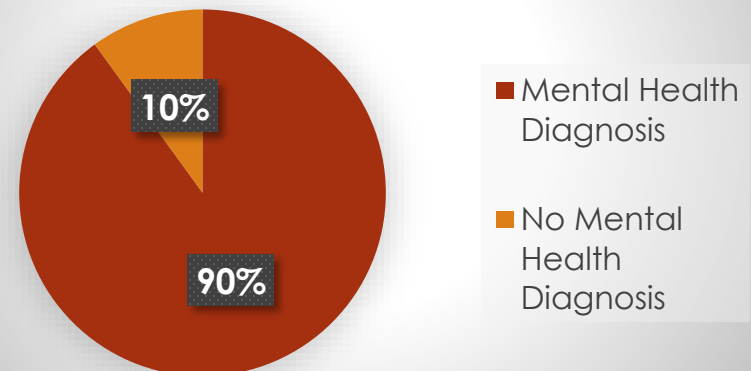
## Substance Abuse
