

University of Toledo Prerequisite Courses

The Academic Council of the American Physical Therapy Association (APTA) voted at its October 2012 annual meeting to support a list of standard prerequisite courses required for admission into an entry-level physical therapist education program. The DPT Program at UT has adopted this standard list of prerequisites. The following are the standard prerequisites described by the Academic Council of the APTA and the UT and BGSU courses that are the equivalent of these prerequisites.

NOTE: Seven out of the ten prerequisite courses MUST be completed at the time of application. Since the deadline to apply to UT's DPT Program is October 1, the 7 out of 10 prerequisite courses must be completed BEFORE fall semester.
