- 1 Demonstrate specialized knowledge of human communication
  - 1.1 Demonstrate knowledge of basic human communication and swallowing processes including the appropriate biological, neurological, acoustic, psychological, developmental, and linguistic and cultural bases.
  - 1.2 Demonstrate the ability to integrate information pertaining to normal and abnormal human development across the life span.
  - 1.3 Demonstrate knowledge of standards of ethical conduct.
- 2 Demonstrate skills for prevention, evaluation and intervention and management of communication disorders
  - 2.1 Shall select or use appropriate plans, strategies, materials or instrumentation for prevention, intervention and progress evaluation of clients/patients in a limited clinical experience.
  - 2.2 Demonstrate skills in oral and written or other forms of communication sufficient for entry into professional practice.
  - 2.3 Adhere to the ASHA code of ethics
- 3. Demonstrate professional behavior interaction and personal qualities
  - 3.1 Communicate effectively, recognizing the needs, values, preferred mode of communication, and cultural/linguistic background of others, including colleagues, faculty, staff, client/patient, caregivers, and relevant others.
  - 3.2 Create communication that demonstrates content knowledge, deep reflection, creativity and critical thinking skills to effectively evaluate collaborative products and processes.
