

## **What-if Degree Audits Available in Self-Service for UT Students**

The "What-if" degree audits are available in Self-service for UT students. What-if audits allow students to run a degree audit in different college/major from their current college/major, thus giving students an opportunity to start a conversation with their faculty or professional advisor about either switching majors or pursuing a dual major.

Currently we can run What-if audits with one major and one concentration. For the majors that require two concentrations, you will have to run the What-if audits twice, (each time selecting a different concentration). For students with two majors, Self Service will continue to run their primary major when the "Run Audit" button is selected. However, students can now run their second major as a What-if audit. Viewing an audit for each major will allow students to easily work with their advisor to determine which courses can be used in the total programs for both majors.

The degree audit's current design took into consideration what faculty advisors want and expect; however, some colleges do not want dual majors to be automatically coded together. Because not all colleges' degree programs are designed the same way, students interested in pursuing a dual major or dual degree should follow-up with their college or department advisor to verify approved combinations of courses.
