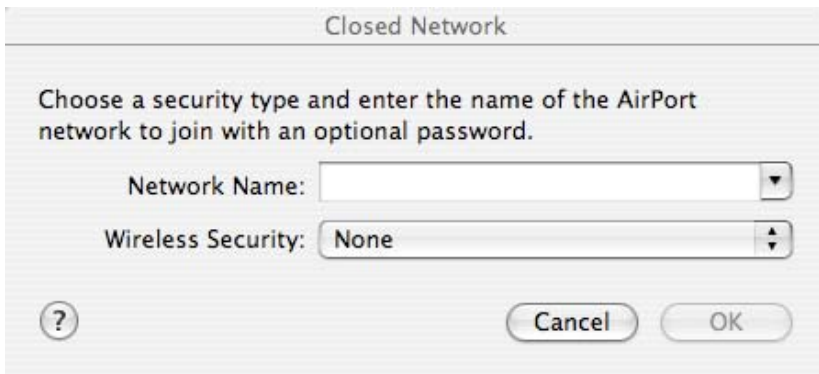
1. Click on the **Wireless Icon** located at the **top right hand corner**.



2. Select **Other**.




3. An **Airport box** will show up.



4. In Network Name type **Private**



5. Select **802.1X WEP** for Wireless Security

10. A **Verify Certificate** box will show up.

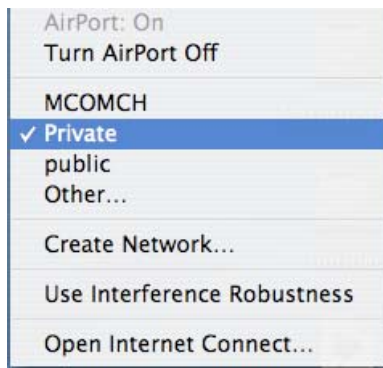


11. Click **Continue**.
