The Law School Admission Council (LSAC) recently announced the Justice Innovation Challenge, which will award up to \$15,000 in seed funding and mentorship to law students with compelling ideas for addressing access to justice issues. Open to all current law students in the U.S., the challenge requires individuals and teams of up to four members to collaborate with a nonprofit legal services organization to assist low-income people in need of legal support. Issues the teams will focus on include domestic violence, consumer debt, evictions, business entity formation, foreclosures, and access to government benefits.
