Biographical/Historical Sketch

Karen Gottlieb Stone is a photographer and writer who contracted multiple sclerosis. From 1990 -1999, she wrote a column for the *Albuquerque Journal* entitled "Meeting the Challenge," and in 1997 her book, *Awakening to Disability: Nothing About Us Without Us*, was published.

Scope and Content Note

This collection contains photocopies of articles written by Karen Gottlieb Stone, primarily her column from the *Albuquerque Journal* entitled "Meeting the Challenge." The articles provide a personal perspective on disability, and occasionally address issues relating to the Disability Rights movement.
