Finding Articles

SocINDEX OhioLINK Research Database (1895-)

Provides full text of journal articles, and indexing and informative abstracts for "core" coverage journals in sociology dating back to 1895.

Sociological Abstracts OhioLINK Research Database (1963-2005)

An index to research sponsored in sociology and related disciplines in the social and behavioral sciences. Note: coverage ends in 2005.

Social Sciences Citation Index OhioLINK Research Database (1980-)

Provides access to current and retrospective bibliographic information, author abstracts, and cited references found in over 1,700 of the world's leading scholarly social sciences journals covering more than 50 disciplines.

Electronic Journal Center OhioLINK (EJC) Research Database

The EJC includes the full text of more than 7000 online research journals covering many subject areas. Most electronic indexes available to the Ohio academic community link from article citations to the full text in the EJC.

Dictionaries and Encyclopedias

The Blackwell Dictionary of Sociology

HM17 .J64 1995

It presents many of the discipline's core concepts and a few important concepts from related disciplines. Biographical sketches of major figures in the development and practice of sociology are also provided.

The Concise Oxford Dictionary of Sociology

HM17.C66 1994 Reference

A single volume designed to meet the needs of those new to sociology as well as those familiar with the discipline

The HarperCollins Dictionary of Sociology

HM17 .J38 1991y Reference

This dictionary includes major and minor sociological terms and topics that have been central in the development of the discipline. Entries also include some of the most influential sociologists.

The Blackwell Encyclopedia of Sociology

HM425 .B53 2007 Reference

Represents the largest and most complete, diverse, global, and up-to-date encyclopedia of sociology in the history of the discipline. It is an effort to define the field of sociology in 2007 and a platform to continue to define it into the future.

Encyclopedia of Disability

HV1568 .E528 2006 Reference

It is a broad perspective on the experience of disability.

Brief entries on cutting-edge topics, such as globalization, consumption, and actor network theory, in addition to state-of-the-art interpretations of long-established theories.
