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Thanked Council for invitation and assured as Provost to do no harm; realizes change to one Provost  COM&LS more distinctive than most units; will respect and deal with the clinical and teaching components appropriately  Faculty Hiring Plan and Summary  Constructed more toward teaching model  COM&LS will be acceptation & handled differently  Step 1: Look at where the unit wants to go and not lose expertise; new opportunity to investigate options/structure  Step 2: Estimate retirements  Dean has been working with department chairs and some have already submitted plans; vast majority of retires will go back to colleges if needed but some will go back to Provost (centrally)  Hope to use this opportunity to break silos and have more cooperation  COM&LS will have higher % of faculty lines returned because of clinical mission; basic science will be more affected  Will be given 3 years to fill a line if not able to hire immediately; make sure to hire the person truly desired  Step 3: rehires; work with departments and mutual agreement with faculty member  Q: How will strategic hiring plan influence the overlap between COM&LS and Main Campus graduate programs?  A: Clinical mission a non-starter; majority of lines to COM&LS allocate among themselves; many fields with retires will allow hiring at lower pay  Q: Does hiring plan include startup funds for good research?  A: Dean working to address research growth; COM&LS is different and the clinical area must grow & need to be strategic and thoughtful  Talked about collaboration across colleges; cross college teaching in the future; spoke about enrollment decline on Main Campus which has affected growth
