The recommended text for Internal Medicine will be Cecil Essentials of Medicine, edited by Thomas E. Andreoli, et al, 7th ed, WB Saunders, 2007. This is an excellent, easily readable text, which covers the major topics in Internal Medicine.

Harrison's Principles of Internal Medicine, 17th Edition by Fauci, et al, McGraw-Hill, 2008, is another excellent textbook.

You will need to be acquainted with the material in this text in order to pass the Subject Exam at the end of this rotation and the Internal Medicine portion of the National Boards. You will not see enough disease variety in your patient population during this rotation to adequately cover all of the important topics in Internal Medicine. You must keep up with your reading during the rotation or you will not pass the Subject Exam. The students will be expected to read in depth on their own patients from one of the major medical textbooks.
