## Introduction

The University of Toledo College of Medicine and Life Sciences General Psychiatry Residency Program does not discriminate with regard to sex, race, age, religion, color, national origin, disability, or any other applicable legally protected status.

## Requirements

- Completed ERAS application
- Personal statement
- 3 Letters of recommendation, written by US physicians and dated within the past 12 months
- Official medical school transcript (with registrar's signature and seal)
- Dean's letter of MSPE (Medical School Performance Evaluation), if applicable
- No H-1B visa sponsorships

## Score Requirements

- **USMLE Step 1:** Preference is given to candidates who pass on the first attempt and with Step 1 scores of 200 or greater
- **USMLE Step 2CK:** Preference is given to candidates who pass on the first attempt and with Step 2CK scores of 225 or greater
- **USMLE Step 2CS:** Preference is given to candidates who pass on the first attempt
- **USMLE Step 3:** If applicable, preference is given to candidates who pass on the first attempt

- **COMLEX Level 1:** Preference is given to candidates who pass on the first attempt and with Level 1 scores of 425 or greater
- **COMLEX Level 2CE:** Preference is given to candidates who pass on the first attempt and with Level 2 CE scores of 425 or greater
- **COMLEX Level 2PE:** Preference is given to candidates who pass on the first attempt
