To Be Completed by: All Incoming Residents/Fellows (prior to July 1, 2013)

- The basic course in Patient Safety and Quality Improvement is taken from the Institute for Healthcare Improvement (IHI)
- Residents will need to complete two brief on-line modules.
 - Fundamentals of Patient Safety 101 (PS101)
 - Fundamentals of Improvement 101 (QI101)
- Register (found on the top left of the IHI home screen) as follows:
 - Organization: Hospital-Teaching
 - Job Title: Resident
 - Hospital: type in The University of Toledo
 - Do not check the box about being a full or part time student
 - Primary Role: Intern/Resident
- Go to Courses and Certificates
- Enroll in PS101 (Fundamentals of Patient Safety)
- Enroll in QI101 (Fundamentals of Improvement) and complete the modules
