Course Description:

The Bridge Course is designed to introduce incoming third year students to clinical rotations. The Course includes approximately 20 hours of didactic sessions followed by small group breakout sessions that include topics such as clinical skills (including but not limited to presenting information on rounds, writing notes and orders, team leadership, and communicating with patients). Students are exposed to important concepts associated with clinical practice and provided opportunities to understand concepts related to professionalism, clinical knowledge, systems based practice and life long learning.
