Elective Description: The student will have the opportunity to participate in the field of gynecology, minimally invasive surgery and urogynecology. The student will be integrated in to the gynecology service as an acting intern on the team and be involved with outpatient clinics, inpatient care, and surgery. The student will be exposed to all areas of gynecology; surgery, pathology, radiology and emergency room consultations.
