**Elective Description/** 

Requirements:

This clerkship is designed to expose students to a variety of urologic disorders seen in an inpatient or outpatient setting. Designed for students considering a career in Urology or a surgical discipline. Students will be designated as an Acting Intern with increased responsibility for patient management – under supervision. The student will also be exposed to the

variety and complexity of urologic diagnostic testing and surgical intervention.

**Length of Clerkship**: 4 weeks

5. Facilitated small-group weekly sessions
