<u>Elective Description/ Requirements:</u>	This clerkship is designed to expose students to a variety of pediatric urologic problems including voiding disorders, urinary infections, undescended testes and congenital penile abnormalities. This clerkship will be especially beneficial for students considering a career in Pediatrics or in Urology.

Hospital-based: rounds on inpatients with residents with review and discussion of care
