GENERAL INFORMATION FOR VETERAN AND DEPENDENT STUDENTS

G.I. Bill Educational Benefits are payable for regular attendance in courses that are a part of your curriculum. You will not receive VA benefits for enrollment in classes that are not required for your degree or graduation.

VA students may not be paid for re-enrolling in a course(s) that was taken at a former college or university if the course is accepted as transfer credit at The University of Toledo.

The VA will not pay for repeated course work for which you received a passing grade unless you are **REQUIRED** to do so.

The VA may or may not pay for remedial course work. If you have questions as to whether a course is remedial or whether you are eligible for benefits for a particular course, contact the VA coordinator before registering for the class.

GRADES THAT WILL IMPACT YOUR BENEFITS:

AU – Audit – no benefit

Z – No Grade – no benefits – contact VA coordinator immediately

NC – No Credit – no benefits – you must report last date of attendance to the VA coordinator

W/IW – benefits will be paid through the last date of attendance if the VA approves your statement of mitigating circumstances. If the VA does not approve your mitigating circumstances, you will be held liable for repayment of benefits received. You must report the last date you attended the class to the VA coordinator within two weeks after the date you last attended the class. Failure to provide the last date of attendance for a withdrawal will result in a forfeit of all benefits for that course.

IN – According to University policy, all incomplete grades must be completed by the end of the following term. After that time, any incomplete grade will automatically be converted to an F grade.

PR – Progress Grade – will be reported to the VA as a “no credit” grade. When the PR grade is changed to a punitive grade, the VA will be notified and benefits may be reinstated for the PR course.

You will not be paid for Physical Education coursework. However, you may be eligible to receive credit for military service by completing a request for your military transcript from the Military Service Center.

If you complete the semester and receive a non-punitive grade (i.e. no credit for a grade/no credit class) or simply do not receive a grade for a class, the course will not be paid through the Veteran’s Administration.

All students who do not maintain satisfactory academic progress as defined by University policy will be subject to academic probation or suspension. In addition to this University policy, a student who is receiving VA educational benefits will, for purposes of VA education benefits, be terminated at the end of two consecutive terms of academic probation without improvement in his/her academic standing.
