Stephanie completed her Bachelors of Business Administration with a minor in Environmental Science in 2015. For her Capstone Senior Project Stephanie initiated the use of native plants for landscaping projects on the Dorr and Centennial roundabouts. This project included coordination with Lucas County Engineers, organizing and arranging transportation for volunteers, and development of a flier to educate community members about the project.

Stephanie also worked as a crew leader during her time as a Hand Construction Intern in 2014, during which time her responsibilities included supervision of the crew in accordance with OSHA's standard regulations, training new staff, and leading a crew of up to six at-risk adults.



After graduating from the University of Toledo Stephanie started as a Direct Support Professional at Bittersweet Farms, where she maintained a positive and safe environment when taking individuals on social and recreational outings and assisted with client financial management. Stephanie is currently an Environmental Education Interpreter with Toledo Metroparks. Her responsibilities include creating and implementing programs and lesson plans for nature camps, developing an interactive training segment for Counselors in Training on nature walk behavior, and working with other members of the Metroparks Communication Team to create an enhanced understanding of how parks benefit the community. Stephanie is an Ohio Certified Volunteer Naturalist, a Project House of Hope Ambassador, and an active volunteer for Wild Ones of the Oak Openings Region.
