

RE: **Recommendations for Honorary Degrees for May 2015**

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The Academic Honors Committee has voted to recommend the nominations of two candidates to the Board of Trustees for consideration for honorary degrees, to be conferred at the Spring Semester Commencement on May 10, 2015.

**Mr. Roy Armes** was appointed as the Chief Executive Officer and President of Cooper Tire and Rubber, Company in 2006 and one year later he was also appointed Chairman. He earned his B.S. In Mechanical Engineering from The University of Toledo in 1975 and, for the next 31 years, he worked in a variety of capacities at The Whirlpool Corporation in the areas of engineering, manufacturing, global procurement and international operations management. Some of his significant appointments include an array of international posts. He served as the Corporate Vice President and General Director of Whirlpool, Mexico, S.A. De CV, Vice President of Manufacturing Technology- Whirlpool Asia (Singapore), and Vice President Manufacturing Technology-Refrigeration Products of Whirlpool Europe (Italy). He serves on a number of boards including appointments as Director of JLG Industries (2000-present), Director of The Manitowoc Company, Inc. (2010-present) and, since 2013 he also has served as its Presiding Director. He currently serves as Director of AGCO Corp. and Trustee of the Manufacturer's Alliance for Productivity & Innovation Inc. From 2011-13, he chaired the Rubber Manufacturers of America (RMA). In 2009, he and his wife, Marcia, were instrumental in establishing the Engineering Leadership Institute (ELI) in the UT College of Engineering to assist undergraduate engineering students gain critical leadership skills to complement their academic skills. He is committed to a number of community organizations including service with the Alzheimer's Association.

**Mr. Keith L. Faber** represents the 12<sup>th</sup> State Senate District in western Ohio, encompassing all of Allen, Champaign, Mercer, and Shelby counties as well as portions of Auglaize, Darke and Logan counties. He is currently serving as the 94<sup>th</sup> President of the Ohio Senate (2013-15). Prior to his election to the Senate, he served three terms in the Ohio House of Representatives (2001-06). Mr. Faber is the principal partner with Faber and Associates in Celina, OH- a law firm specializing in civil litigation and mediation. He earned his B.S. in Public Administration/Policy with honors from Oakland University (MI) in 1988 and his J.D. from The Ohio State University in 1991. Prior to his appointment to the Senate leadership, Sen. Faber served on several important Senate committees involved with fiscal

management, including his roles as Chairman of the Senate Standing Committee on Government Oversight and Vice Chairman of the Senate Insurance, Commerce & Labor Committee, as well as membership on the budget-writing Finance & Financial Institutions Committee. Sen. Faber also represents the Senate on the State Ballot Board, the Joint Legislative Ethics Committee, the Legislative Service Commission Board, and the Redistricting, Reapportionment & Demographic Research Legislative Taskforce. He has received recognitions for his work including those as a Watchdog of the Treasury (five times between 2004 and 2012), Guardian of Small Business Award in 2010, and Outstanding Legislator of the Year (2004) by the United Conservatives of Ohio. He has been an active member in legal organizations including the Ohio State Bar Association's Public Understanding of the Law Advisory Board and the Board of Editors of the Ohio Lawyer Magazine. Mr. Faber also has many years of dedicated service with civic organizations in Celina and Mercer counties.

### **Chairman, CEO & President Cooper Tire & Rubber Company**

Roy Armes is Chairman, CEO and President of Cooper Tire & Rubber Company. He joined the company in December 2006 as its CEO and President. A year later, he was also appointed Chairman.

As one of its distinguished alumni, Armes, along with his wife Marcia, joined Engineering Department Dean Nagi Naganathan to establish the Engineering Leadership Institute (ELI) in 2009. The Institute helps engineering students develop critical leadership skills in addition to their academic pursuits, which is essential for career success in today's globally competitive business environment. Armes is also active in a number of non-profit and community organizations, including recent service as an Honorary Chairman of the Alzheimer's Association Walk to End Alzheimer's (Findlay, Ohio), among others.

The Academic Honors Committee has voted to recommend the nomination of Dr. Roubideaux to the Board of Trustees for consideration for an honorary degree to be conferred at the Spring Commencement of the College of Medicine and Life Sciences on May 29, 2015.

Yvette Roubideaux, M.D., M.P.H., is Senior Advisor to the Secretary for American Indians and Alaska Natives, Department of Health and Human Services and the principal Federal health care advocate and provider for American Indian and Alaska Native peoples. She received her B.A. (biology) degree, cum laude, and her M.D. degree from Harvard Medical School and completed primary care internal medicine residency training at Brigham and Women's Hospital, Boston and a Master's in Public Health degree from the Harvard School of Public Health. Her fellowship training in Minority Health Policy was at the Commonwealth Fund/Harvard University and in Indian Health at the Native American Center, University of Washington at Seattle. She was a medical/clinical officer at several Indian Hospitals (1992-1996) before serving as an Assistant Professor of Family and Community Medicine at the University of Arizona (1997-2006), where she directed programs to enhance American Indian and Alaskan Native student enrollment in health and research professions. She served as Director of Indian Health Services in the Department of Health and Human Services from 2009-2013 and as Acting Director of the Indian Health Services for the last two years. She served as Vice-Chair of the Interdepartmental Council on Native American Affairs, Department of Health and Human Services (2009-2015). In these roles, Dr. Roubideaux administered a \$4.4 billion nationwide health care delivery program providing preventive, curative and community health care to ~2.2 million American Indians and Alaskan Natives.



She is past president of the Association of American Indian Physicians and an active researcher on American Indian health policy and health issues, focusing on diabetes in American Indian and Alaskan Natives. She was Co-Director of the Special Diabetes Program for Indians Competitive Grant Program on Diabetes and Cardiovascular Disease, leading to a large number of communities implementing diabetes prevention and cardiovascular disease prevention initiatives. Her honors are numerous and include the Award of Merit from the National Diabetes Education Program, NIH/CDC (2000), the Outstanding American Indian Faculty Award from the Native American Student Affairs, University of Arizona (2002), a Special Recognition from the Office of the Governor, State of Arizona (2004), listing on the Honor Wall at the National Museum of the American Indian in Washington DC (2004), and the Surgeon General's Medallion (2013), among many others.

Dear Provost Barrett:

It is my pleasure to formally nominate Yvette Roubideaux, M.D., M.P.H., as an Honorary Degree recipient and commencement speaker for the spring 2015 Commencement of the College of Medicine. Dr. Roubideaux is the Acting Director of the Indian Health Service (IHS). The IHS is an agency within the Department of Health and Human Services and is the principal federal health care advocate and provider for American Indians and Alaska Natives. A committee of medical students and faculty selected Dr. Roubideaux from a national pool in recognition of her service to our country and American Indians and Alaskan Natives throughout her career.

Dr. Roubideaux has an outstanding resume. In her role at the IHS, she administers a \$4.4 billion nationwide health care delivery program that is responsible for providing preventive, curative, and community health care to approximately 2.2 million American Indians and Alaska Natives in hospitals, clinics, and other settings throughout the United States. Before becoming Acting Director of the IHS, she also served for three years as a medical officer and clinical director at the San Carlos Service Unit on the San Carlos Apache Indian reservation in Arizona, and also served for one year as a medical officer at the Hu Hu Kam Memorial Indian Hospital on the Gila River Indian reservation in Arizona.

Dr. Roubideaux has served in other leadership roles including Assistant Professor of Family and Community Medicine at the University of Arizona College of Medicine. She has been extremely active in research on American Indian health issues, with a focus on diabetes in American Indians/Alaska Natives and American Indian health policy. Dr. Roubideaux served as the co-director of the Special Diabetes Program for Indians Demonstration Projects, in which a large number of American Indian and Alaska Native communities implemented diabetes prevention and cardiovascular disease prevention initiatives. She also served as director of two University of Arizona programs designed to recruit American Indian and Alaska Native students in to health and research professions.

Dr. Roubideaux served as past President of the Association of American Indian Physicians. She has authored several monographs and peer-reviewed publications on American Indian/Alaska Native health issues, research, and policy.

Dr. Roubideaux obtained her medical degree from the Harvard Medical School and completed a residency program in primary care internal medicine at Brigham and Women's Hospital in Boston. She received her Master of Public Health degree at the Harvard School of Public Health. She also completed a fellowship in Minority Health Policy at the Commonwealth Fund/Harvard University before beginning her career in academic medicine and public health.
