(A) Policy statement

Students who are officially registered at a Liaison Committee of Medical Education (LCME) or American Osteopathic Association (AOA) accredited medical school may be accepted for elective clerkships at MUO.

(B) Purpose of policy

To assure that visiting medical students fulfill the University of Toledo College of Medicine's requirements for students to participate in elective clinical clerkships.

(D) Procedure

In order for a visiting student to qualify for elective clerkship at UTCOM:

1. Acceptance and approval of the student must be obtained from the UTCOM departmental elective clerkship director.
2. Students must register at UTCOM, but will not be identified as UTCOM students.
3. The clerkship grade will be reported to the student's "home" medical school.
4. Appropriate fees may be charged.

Students from medical schools which are not accredited by LCME may be accepted only upon recommendation by the Associate Dean for Clinical Medical Education and authorization by the Dean.

All visiting medicine students are required to have health care and professional liability insurance and demonstrate immunity to rubella, mumps, measles (MMR), and Hepatitis B. A physical examination and proof of testing for tuberculosis (TB) within the previous 12 months and training in universal precautions must also be provided.
