(A) Policy statement

The University will properly examine all students in the College of Medicine, College of Nursing and those students who register for classes through the registrar on the Health Science Campus in the College of Health Service and Human Service and the College of Graduate Studies to determine whether they qualify as Ohio residents under Ohio Administrative Code 3333.31.

(B) Purpose of policy

As a public, state-supported University in Ohio, The University of Toledo Health Science Campus provides educational programs to residents of the State of Ohio at established tuition rates depending upon the program of study. Students who are not residents of Ohio are assessed a program-dependent tuition surcharge to attend The University of Toledo. The University is obligated to designate the non-resident status of all enrolled students in accordance with the residency rule established by the Ohio Board of Regents and codified in the Ohio Administrative Code.

(D) Procedure

Applicants to the programs to the Health Science Campus must specify whether they are residents of the State of Ohio on their admissions application. In accordance with Ohio Board of Regents guidelines, each applicant must indicate whether or not they have lived in Ohio for the previous 12 months.

Non-residents may request to be considered for in-state residency status by completing the Request for Ohio Residency Status for Tuition and Subsidy Purposes form and providing all required documentation.

The Residency Officer will review each application, and has the authority to request additional documentation from the student deemed important in validating the student's claim that they qualify for in-state residency status. When necessary, the Residency Officer will confer with the HSC General Counsel's Office to ensure that the university's decisions comply with the Ohio Board of Regent's residency rule as promulgated in Ohio Administrative Code 3333.31, as may be amended from time to time, and fully adopted and incorporated by reference into this policy.
