POLICY

Funding will be provided to residents when on overnight call and they must stay in the hospital.

PURPOSE

To provide meals for residents that are required to remain in the hospital for extended hours.

PROCEDURE

Funds will be loaded onto the resident ID Badge at the beginning of each month to cover the expense of meals while on call as follows:

- 1. All programs with overnight call at UTMC will adopt this uniform policy.
- 2. Call After Assigned Shift: Resident will receive a total of \$10.00
- 3. Weekend call which consists of a 24+ hours: Resident will receive a total of \$20.00
- 4. Funds left over from will not be carried over to the next month.
- 6. When rotating at other hospitals, house staff will follow policy at that institution.
