POLICY



Externships/observerships, defined as a period of time during which a person with a medical degree observes or participates in patient management without pay or credit, will not be granted to any individuals.

PURPOSE

To remain in compliance with the regulations and to maintain patient safety, no externships or observerships will be permitted.

PROCEDURE

When queried about participation in externships or observerships, Graduate Medical Education programs at the University of Toledo will need to inform those wishing to pursue these experiences that they are not permitted.
