(A) Policy statement

The University of Toledo is committed to following all National Collegiate Athletic Association, Mid-American Conference, and institutional guidelines concerning the reporting of athletically related outside income by staff members and coaches. Athletic department staff members will annually provide a list of all athletically related outside income. The final report will be presented to the university president for signature.

(B) Purpose of policy

NCAA rules require that all staff members and coaches annually report athletically related outside income to the university’s chief executive officer.

(C) Procedures

At the conclusion of the fiscal year, the assistant athletics director for compliance will provide an outside income report to all staff members and coaches who were employed by the institution during the previous academic year. Staff members and coaches will complete the report by identifying the following sources of outside income:

- (1) Income from annuities;
- (2) Sports camps;
- (3) Housing benefits (including preferential housing arrangements);
- (4) Country club memberships;
- (5) Complimentary ticket sales;
- (6) Television and radio programs;
- (7) Endorsement or consultation contracts with athletics shoe, apparel or equipment manufacturers; and
- (8) Use of dealer vehicles.

The reports will then be forwarded to the university president for signature.

(D) Definitions

NCAA. National Collegiate Athletic Association; the organization which governs intercollegiate athletics in the United States.
