(A) Policy statement

The university is committed to demonstrating honor and allegiance to the United States of America, the state of Ohio, and this University, through presentation of flags as well to provide guidance for the display of flags on the University of Toledo campuses not addressed by existing laws, regulations, and codes.

(B) Purpose of policy

The purpose of this policy is to ensure continuity with all memorial celebrations by reflecting uniformity at all University of Toledo owned or operated facilities, and to address the request for display of flags of symbolism that represent the values of the University.

(C) Procedure

- (a) Authorized flags will include the display of the American, POW/MIA, state of Ohio and University of Toledo flags. The President of the University of Toledo will authorize the presentation of flags.
- (b) Federal and state guidelines shall be observed.
- (c)(b) The American, state of Ohio and University of Toledo flags will be presented every day at full mast.
- (d)(c) The flags will be flown in a consistent manner at all facilities.
- (e) The flags will be replaced as needed to ensure their integrity.
- (f)(d) The President of the University of Toledo may authorize other flags to be flown.
- (g)(e) Flag presentation, other than at full maststaff, will be directed by the President of the United States, by the Governor of the State of Ohio or the President of the University of Toledo.
- (f) Time frame for display at half-mast staff will be specified.

(D) Flag of Symbolism Procedure

- University-sanctioned clubs, organizations, and departments may request that a flag of symbolism, representing the values of the University, be flown in the designated location for a minimum of 24 hours and a maximum of seven days.
- (a) The Vice President of Student Affairs may authorize flags of symbolism to be flown to reflect the University's values. Such authorization will be based on the University's determination of the appropriateness of the occasion and not upon request by individuals or organizations.
- (b) Approval of these requests will be obtained from the Vice President of

 Student Affairs. The Vice President may designate a person or person(s) to
 enforce this policy.
- The Vice President of Student Affairs will submit the request to a committee consisting of the following:
 - A representative of Student Government
 - A representative of Graduate Student Association
 - A representative of Faculty Senate
 - A representative designated by the Provost
 - A designee of the Vice President, who will also serve as the chair of the committee
- The committee will recommend to the Vice President whether to raise the flag and what dates the flag will fly.
- (c) The location(s) for flags of symbolism to be displayed Flag of Symbolism

 location will be designated by the Senior Associate Vice President for

 Administration.
- The sponsoring organization must provide the flag to be flown, and it must be professionally produced and outfitted to fly on a flagpole. The flag must be 4' by 6' in size.
- Upon approval by the Vice President, the sponsoring organization will provide the flag to the Director of Facilities Operations to arrange for the flag raising and flag lowering on the approved date(s).
