(A) Policy statement


The residence halls of the University are not open to the public and are reserved for the use of the residents and their guests. As such the general public does not have open access to these buildings.

(B) Purpose of policy

The needs of roommates/suitemates to sleep, study, to be comfortable and otherwise free from interference and disruption as well as the right to privacy are paramount.

(C) Certain convicted felons not permitted to reside in a University housing facility.

Students having been convicted or having plead guilty to a felony offense defined as an offense of violence under section 2901.01(A)(9) of the Revised Code or which involve the use, sale or distribution of a controlled substance in violation of the Ohio Revised Code or other applicable law shall not be permitted to reside in a University housing facility.
