(A) Policy statement

Major revision of existing policy

The adult cardiac catheterization services may perform cardiac catheterization services to patients ages 18-22 years if the patients' attending physician and the Medical Director of the adult cardiac catheterization service determine that such service will best serve the needs of the patient.

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Reaffirmation of existing policy

(B) Purpose of policy

To comply with the provision of rules 3701-84-30 to 3701-84-34 of the Ohio Administrative Code.

(C) Procedure

- (1) The scheduler of the cardiac catheterization services will notify the Medical Director or his designee, when a patient aged 18-22 years is scheduled for a procedure.
- (2) The Medical Director or his designee will notify the patient's attending of record and discuss the pending case.
- (3) After such discussion with the patients' attending physician, the Medical Director or his designee will notify the cardiac catheterization service scheduler, whether to proceed with the scheduling process for the patient.
