## (A) Policy Statement

Clinical Nutrition staff involved in direct patient care shall be aware of potential for ethical questions and conflicts relating to that care.

## (B) Purpose of Policy

To ensure that clinical staff understand potential ethical situations and are able to demonstrate competency in the following areas:

- Conflict/Dilemma Resolution
- Advance Directives (OBRA) Patient Self Determination Act
- Withholding/Withdrawing Medical Care
- Care at End of Life

## (C) Procedure

- 1. Dietitians/Technicians are knowledgeable about how the hospital addresses care at the end of life.
- 2. Nutritional care documentation indicates that family participates in nutritional care decisions when appropriate.
- 3. Refer to Hospital Administration policy on refusal of life sustaining treatments (3364-100-45-01).
