(A) Policy statement



It is the policy of the University of Toledo Medical Center that a general consent form signed by or on behalf of every patient admitted to the Hospital must be obtained at the time of admission. The admitting officer shall notify the attending physician whenever such consent has not been obtained. When so notified, it shall be, except in an emergency, the attending physician's obligation to obtain proper consent before the patient is treated in the hospital.

(B) Purpose of policy

To ensure consent for treatment for patients presenting to University of Toledo Medical Center for admission.
