Title: HYDROGEN BREATH TEST (HBT) GUIDELINES

<u>Responsibility</u>: Endoscopy Registered Nurse (RN)

Purpose of Guidelines: The purpose is to provide standardization for the Hydrogen Breath Test procedure.

<u>Procedure</u>: IMPORTANT: Check order to confirm type of solution to be used. Diagnosis determines which type of sugar patient will drink.

- 1. Check battery level on device and check calibration log (complete calibration if due).
- 2. If patient is diabetic, obtain fasting blood sugar and record. If blood sugar abnormal, contact ordering provider for guidance.
- 3. Have patient brush their teeth before starting study.
- 4. Obtain baseline breath reading and record on HBT sheet and in Minor Procedure tab in EPIC.
- 5. Mix sugar drink per manufacturer's instructions.
- 6. Patient must drink sugar solution within 10-15 minutes.
- 7. Patient must brush teeth again.
- 8. Obtain second baseline and record on HBT sheet and in EPIC.
- 9. Continue measurements at frequencies indicated by solution specific protocol and record results on HBT sheet and in EPIC.
- 10. Disinfect device per manufacturer's instructions once testing is complete.
