

Nursing Service Guidelines General Nursing Guideline

Title: BRONCHOSCOPY (EMERGENT AND NON-EMERGENT)

Responsibility: Registered Nurse

Purpose of Guidelines: The purpose of this guideline is to ensure the appropriate location of

those patients requiring a bronchoscopy.

Procedure:

1. A negative airflow room is required for all patients in airborne precautions. Refer to the following policy:

Infection Control Precautions, Policy number 3364-109-ISO-404 Tuberculosis Exposure Control Plan

- 2. For all Bronchoscopies (emergent and non-emergent) a negative airflow room is preferred.
- 3. Non emergent bronchoscopies are to be performed in the following locations in order of preference:
 - a. Endoscopy Suite (any ICU patient going to endoscopy will require an ICU nurse to travel and to remain with the patient throughout the procedure)
 - b. Negative Airflow Room
- 4. N-95 mask or PAPR will be worn by all staff members in attendance for any procedures that are to rule out TB or any other pulmonary infection. A surgical mask may be worn by all staff for any other procedures.
