

## Nursing Service Guidelines General

Title: IDENTIFICATION AND COMMUNICATION OF

RESTRICTED EXTREMITY USE

Responsibility: All patient care personnel

**Purpose of Guidelines:** To have a standardized process that identifies patients with restrictions

on the use of one or more extremities for the purpose of invasive and

non-invasive procedures.

## **Procedure:**

1. A 'limb alert' bracelet will be applied to the affected limb upon admission or at point of service, determining that an extremity has been deemed restricted.

- 2. No laboratory venous draws, no Intravenous (IV) starts, and no blood pressures are to be performed on the affected limb.
- 3. The 'limb alert' bracelet will be left on the affected limb until either the restriction is lifted or at the time of patient discharge from the hospital.
