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(A) Policy Statement

All patients with End Stage Renal Disease (ESRD) on hemodialysis will be informed of the appropriate action to take in the case of a medical or non-medical emergency.

(B) Purpose of Policy

To provide ESRD patients on hemodialysis with written information on how to handle a medical or non-medical emergency.

(C) Procedure

- 1. At the initiation of chronic hemodialysis the ESRD patient will receive a written protocol on handling medical and non-medical emergencies by the dialysis staff.
- 2. The protocol will be reviewed with the patient.
- 3. The emergency take off procedure will be reviewed with patients and documented in Epic.

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It is the responsibility of the reader to verify with the responsible agent that this is the most current version of the policy.
