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## (A) Policy Statement

To assure that sufficient staffing is available to provide safe hemodialysis procedures.

## (B) Purpose of Policy

To establish basic minimum requirements and qualifications for nursing staff in the Hemodialysis Unit.

## (C) Procedure

- 1. The nurse patient staffing ratio will be determined by the patient acuity level. Basic minimum staffing will be 1 nurse to 3 patients.
- 2. Dialysis staff will notify the House Supervisor (HS) and/or Nursing Director when supplemental staffing is needed due to increased unit activity and patient acuity.
- 3. On-call staffing coverage will be rotated among staff nurses who have successfully completed orientation.
- 4. On-call coverage is scheduled for staff nurses once per week, and an occasional day per week as needed. .
