## (A) Policy Statement

The cardiothoracic surgery service may perform cardiothoracic surgery on patients aged 18-22 years, if the patient's attending physician and the Medical Director of the cardiothoracic surgery service determine that such service will benefit the patient.

## (B) Purpose of Policy

The purpose is to comply with the provision (A) rules 3701-84-36 of the Ohio Administrative Code.

## (C) Procedure

- (1) The Cardiothoracic Surgery Medical Director or his/her designee will contact the patient's attending of record and/or cardiologist and discuss the pending case.
- (2) After such discussion with the patient's attending physician, the Medical Director or his/her designee will notify the cardiothoracic surgery scheduler to schedule surgery.
