(A) Policy Statement

All patients undergoing surgery will be admitted to the Pre-Op Holding area prior to surgery.

(B) Purpose of Policy

To establish a consistent protocol and safe environment for the evaluation of patients undergoing surgery.

(C) Procedure

- 1. All patients undergoing a surgical procedure without pre-operative hospitalization will be evaluated by PAT staff. A nursing pre-operative history will be obtained. The nursing plan of care along with pre-operative teaching will be done at this time. If the above is not completed prior to the day of surgery, a holding area nurse will complete the necessary documentation the day of surgery and the pre-anesthesia evaluation will be done day of surgery by the assigned physician.
- 2. All patients undergoing a surgical procedure without pre-operative hospitalization will be admitted pre-operatively to the POH area until moved to the Operating Room. While in the preop area, the nursing assessment and plan of care will be completed.
- 3. Patients undergoing emergency surgical procedures may be moved directly into the Operating Room without admission to the Pre-Op Holding area.
