(A) Policy statement

The comfort and safety of all patients and staff at University of Toledo Medical Center is paramount. Patients who are under the custody of law enforcement have the same health care rights as any other patient.

(B) Purpose of policy

The purpose of this policy is to define safety parameters to be used in the event a prisoner patient presents to a Patient Access department open to the general public, as well as, UTMC and UTP staff members.

(C) Policy

- I. Patient Access staff will:
 - 1. Alert Security when prisoner has arrived
 - 2. Discretely make accommodations to process the prisoner patient as the next in line.
 - 3. Remove all unneeded objects from desk/work station prior to directing the prisoner patient to the registration area.
 - 4. Register the prisoner patient as directed.
 - 5. Alert the clinical service area that the prisoner patient has been processed and is waiting for services.
