## (A) Policy Statement

The Sterile Processing Department will respond appropriately in the event of a planned or unplanned utility shutdown, utilities being electric, water, or communications

## (B) Purpose of Policy

To maintain departmental operations in the safest manner possible to provide safe patient care support to clinical areas of the hospital.

## (C) Procedure

- 1. Planned Utility Interruption
  - a. Facilities Maintenance will notify the Sterile Processing Department as early as possible of an impending, planned utility interruption.
  - b. The department will recommend where possible a shutdown time which coincides with a department slow period, usually between the hours of midnight and 7 A.M. To the extent possible Sterile Processing Department will plan its workload accordingly.
  - c. When a conflict becomes unavoidable, Sterile Processing Department will make arrangements with other local healthcare facilities and or vendors to provide help in sterilization, supplies or equipment.
  - d. Arrangements will be made with facilities maintenance to obtain water and portable lighting if necessary.

## 2. Unplanned Utility Failure

- a. The Manager or Shift Supervisor or designated person will:
  - 1) Determine extent of need and notify Facilities maintenance at ext. 383-5353.
  - 2) Steam: Arrange with other hospitals to sterilize goods.
  - 3) Water: Arrange with Facilities Maintenance to supply water if possible.
  - 4) Electric: Arrange with Facilities maintenance to supply electric power where possible.
- b. Personnel will remain at their stations to perform all duties possible and stand by for further instructions from management.
