Great news for our students!

Do you have a quick question for an academic adviser? Starting November 6, you can get an answer without scheduling an appointment! Walk-In Wednesdays offer quick-time advising for continuing, enrolled students.

Students asked for this service, and we responded! Here are the details.

The hours: Wednesdays, 9 am to 4 pm, beginning Nov. 6

The place: Your college's or department's Student Services Office

You'll be advised on a first-come/first-served basis.

You'll be able to have a short meeting with a college staff adviser for academic issues like:

- Asking about an academic program or your Degree Audit Report
- Identifying an academic resource or service
- Making a particular academic decision (Should I take summer classes? Withdraw? Add a minor?)
- Deciding between a prepared list of course options for next semester's schedule
- Clarifying an academic policy or procedure
- Making an appointment for an extended advising session

Make the most of your time with the adviser by preparing your questions in advance. Then stop in at the Student Services Office of your college or department:
