**II. Basic Description of Responsibility**

The position of Lifeguard comprises three main responsibilities.

- 1.) Responsible for maintaining a safe recreation environment by enforcing policy and following established procedures.
- 2.) Responsible for maintaining a clean facility by completing several cleaning tasks.
- 3.) Responsible to act as an information source and emergency rescue service for patrons and guests by gaining knowledge of facilities as written in the employee handbook and to obtain CPR, First Aid, Lifeguarding and AED training certifications.

**III. Pay Rate**

Rate of Pay = \$7.50/hour Special Event Pay = \$8.50/hour

Opportunities exist for lifeguards to increase pay through swim school, cross training and promotions.

**IV. Employment Requirements**

- Must be enrolled at least part-time (Minimum of 6 hrs) for non-international students or full-time (Minimum of 12hrs) for international students at The University of Toledo. (Excludes summer break)
- International students must have a valid work permit and social security number.
- Must maintain at least a 2.0 GPA to become employed and stay employed
- Must have and maintain current Lifeguard Training, Professional Rescuer CPR, First Aid certification (through the American Red Cross).
- Must have (or earn before first shift) Automatic External Defibrillation (AED) training.
- Must be able to swim 500yds. in 12 minutes or less, at least 200yds. freestyle.
- Must be able to retrieve a 10lb. object from the bottom of a 15ft. deep pool.
- Must be able to perform a successful rescue of a simulated active and/or passive drowning victim with proper American Red Cross CPR protocol.
- Must be scheduled a minimum of 12 hours per week including weekend shifts.
- Will be required to work some weekends and special events which occur before, during, and after operation hours
- Employees may not work more than 40 hours in two weeks while classes are in session.
- Will be required to attend periodic in-service trainings and staff meetings.
