Alcohol and Substance Free Floor Agreement
2009-2010

The Alcohol and Substance Free Floor is intended to provide an active living-learning environment centered on an alcohol and substance free lifestyle. Each resident is expected to participate actively in promoting this concept while living in this environment. To meet the goals of alcohol and substance free living, the following expectations are in place for residents of the floor.

1. While on the floor, residents agree to refrain from using alcohol, cigarettes, tobacco products, other smoking materials, illegal drugs and inhalants; and to ensure that their guests will also follow these guidelines.
2. Residents agree to actively support other community members in their attempts to live an alcohol and substance free lifestyle within the community.
3. Residents agree to refrain from returning to the alcohol and substance free environment if they are under the influence of a substance.
4. Residents agree to work together to set community standards early in the academic year that will define the floor atmosphere.

As a member of an alcohol and substance free environment community, I agree to abide by the above expectations. I understand that failing to do so may result in my removal from the floor and my community.

Please Note:

If you reserve a room on an Alcohol and Substance Free floor, you will be asked to sign this agreement before you move into the residence halls. Failure to do so will result in your room on the Alcohol and Substance Free floor being cancelled and you will be reassigned to any other available space, including a lounge converted to a bedroom, or a local hotel.
