ISU Students heading to Europe this Summer

Sixteen Indiana State University students will spend their summer in Europe through the University of Toledo Rocket Kids program. Indiana State University has partnered with UT to provide ISU students with a unique experiential learning opportunity.

The Rocket Kids internship program is a collaboration with the United States Army that provides educational development and recreational programming for the children of U.S. military families across Europe. ISU students will spend their summers in Germany, the Netherlands, or Italy working as summer camp counselors or assisting in early childhood development centers on U.S. military bases.

In addition to gaining valuable skills, these students will have the opportunity to explore Europe and put Indiana State on the map!
