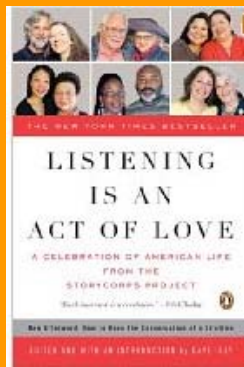


The University of Toledo **FIRST READ 2009**
