The Type Table

This is the way we arrange the sixteen types in a type table.

ISTJ	ISFJ	INFJ	INTJ
ISTP	ISFP	INFP	INTP
ESTP	ESFP	ENFP	ENTP
ESTJ	ESFJ	ENFJ	ENTJ

Sometimes we divide the sixteen types into groups. The groups below use Extraversion or Introversion and Sensing or Intuition. Each group likes to learn for different reasons.

<p>IS Want to learn because they enjoy finding out what is true and right</p>	<p>IN Want to learn because they enjoy learning new ideas and things</p>
<p>ES Want to learn things that they can use in their lives</p>	<p>EN Want to learn ideas or things that they can use to change things</p>

In this example, the types are divided by columns as they are in the table of all sixteen types. The words describe ways each group likes to learn.
