Biographical / Historical

The materials in this collection were donated by Toledo resident George Stamos and offers insight into the activities, businesses, and traditions of the city and surrounding areas. It contains a wide variety of ephemera from local businesses, athletic teams, and performers. For example, the Br Baker Co made men's and boy's clothing from around the 1950's and was located on Adams Street at the corner of Superior. Tiedtke's was a grocery and department store that offered delivery service to customers that opened in the 1894 and continued until 1973 when the store closed. The Toledo Mud Hens is a local baseball team that continues to play and draw in large crowds during baseball season. Magazines from the 1940's have score cards and civic magazines that talked about the different players on the team and how to keep score has become a popular collectors item. The Music category of the collection has several pieces of written music like Please Think of Me and while these pieces do not originate in Ohio or Toledo

they were sold in the Lawrence Meng Music Store on 239 St. Clair Street. There are photographs are of Nancy Norman who performed with Sammy Kaye and his orchestra. Kaye hailed from Lakewood, Ohio and played on Ohio University campus and during vacations around Cleveland when he attended the University. The pamphlets are of guides to Toledo and Ohio, as well as The University of Toledo vs. Miami game on February 6, 1954. Some of the programs and books are from local high schools in the Toledo area such as Scott and Toledo Public schools like the Home Economics Cookbook for Elementary Grades.
