## Kappa Pi Epsilon/Chi Omega Records 1919-1989

#### **Historical Sketch**

The oldest sorority at The University of Toledo, Kappa Pi Epsilon was created in 1912. The group sponsored many social functions such as dances, bridge nights, teas, and various outings. On November 3, 1944, Chi Omega, a national collegiate sorority, installed Kappa Pi Epsilon as its Xi Delta chapter. It was the first national women's fraternity on Toledo's campus.

Chi Omega was founded April 5, 1895, at the University of Arkansas, Fayetteville, Arkansas. From this small beginning Chi Omega has grown to over 120 active chapters. Chi Omega is devoted to friendship, ideals, helpfulness and progress.
