Biographical/Historical Sketch

Dr. Lorin Lee Cary received a Bachelor of Arts degree from Antioch College in 1962 and a master of the arts and doctor of philosophy degree in history from the University of Wisconsin in 1965 and 1968, respectively. He joined the University of Toledo History Department faculty in 1968.

Dr. Cary has received numerous awards for his research and publishing during his career at UT. In 1973, he received the Harry E. Pratt Memorial Award of the Illinois Historical Society for the article, "The Reorganized United Mine Workers of America: 1930-31", which appeared in the Society's journal. He was given a faculty research grant in 1976 to reconstruct the story of one black family, the Bostons of Nantucket Island, Massachusetts, between the years of 1700-1865. He received the Lilly Foundation grant in 1977 and did research into the letters of Powers Hapgood, a Harvard graduate who became a labor organizer during the 1920s. In April 1977, he compiled "A Guide to Research in the History of Toledo", a bibliography for the study of local history.

Dr. Cary was a Fulbright-Hays Senior Scholar at the University of New South Wales in Sydney, Australia in 1980.

In 1984, Dr. Cary and a colleague received the Ohio Academy of History book award and in 1985 the Council of Ohio Genealogists' Henry Howe Prise for No Strength without Union: An Illustrated History of Ohio Workers, 1803-1980. The book was published in 1983 by the Ohio Historical Society as part of its Ohio Labor History Project.

Dr. Cary retired in January 1990 and was awarded the rank of Professor Emeritus of History. After the University of Toledo, Dr. Cary remained active in his research and went on to write *The Custer Conspiracy*. Dr. Cary also spends his time furthering his interest in photography. He was always interested in photographs, and kept his camera around during his years of teaching. His website "Artography by Lorin Lee Cary" showcases his recent work.

Scope and Content Note

This collection contains materials documenting the career and research interests of Dr. Lorin Lee Cary. Included are materials on labor research, local and family history, the administration of the UT history department, and the personal and academic life of Dr. Cary. The collection includes papers, notebooks, photographs, and notecards. Also included are drafts of the book *Slavery in North Caroline*, 1748-1775, that he co-authored with M. Michael Kay in 1995. Much of the material relating to local history and genealogy consists of papers written by students for Dr. Cary's classes on these subjects.

The collection is arranged alphabetically and chronologically depending on the series and subjects.

Series List

S1 Correspondence

Series includes correspondence to and from Dr. Cary. Correspondence is arranged by chronologically. Also included are mailings from organizations that Cary was affiliated with or interested in, also arranged chronologically.

S2 Fran Cary

Included are materials collected by and/or written by Fran Cary. Materials such as correspondence, Collegian articles, and copies from Fran Cary's case are included in this series.

S3 Personal Interests

Includes the personal research and activities of Dr. Cary. Of note is his collection of professional photographs.

S4 Pre- UT

Series covers the publications by Dr. Cary that he wrote before joining the UT faculty in 1968. Also included are class notes that were collected by Cary.

S5 Professional Activities

- **A. Departmental:** Includes materials that relate to the work Dr. Cary was affiliated with within the History Department at UT as well as throughout the university.
- **B. Grant Proposals:** Includes information on the various grants that Dr. Cary requested and received.
- **C. Presentations, Forums, and Conferences:** Subseries includes information and minutes from different conferences either led by or attended by Dr. Cary.

S6 Publications

- A. No Strength without Union: An Illustrated History of Ohio Workers 1803-1980 Roy Boryczka and Lorin Lee Cary: Includes information on the book written by Boryczka and Cary. Materials range from drafts to notes to research materials.
- **B. Other Publications:** Includes published materials that did not fall under the category of either book. Mostly included are reviews on Cary's work.
- C. Slavery in North Carolina, 1748-1775, Lorin Lee Cary and M. Michael L. Kay: Included are materials directly relating to the publication of this book; materials include research sources, articles, notes, notecards, and various reviews of the book.

S7 Students

- **A. Evaluations and Recommendations:** Subseries includes information on various students, mostly letters of recommendation, papers, and other pieces of information pertinent to UT.
- **B. Family History Papers:** Includes students' works on a project by Cary titled "Tracing your Family History".
- **C. Labor History Papers:** Includes students' work on various topics pertaining to the history of labor in the US.
- **D. Local History Papers:** Similar to the Labor History Papers, this subseries includes student works on local history of labor, mainly in Toledo, OH.
- **E. Other Papers:** Contains papers whose content did not fit with the other subseries.
- F. Theses and Dissertations: Includes students' works for their degrees in History.
