- Page 3 of 25-page handout – Goal 1: Communication (this document was the work of Holly Monsos, John Plenefisch, Scott Molitor, Brian Ashburner, Tony Edgington, Scott Hall and Kristen Keith – after a workshop on General Education)
 - Goals, competencies, student learning outcomes, performance indicators and aligned courses
 - This draft list was taken from the core list on the website
- Still need performance indicators – Core Curriculum Committee will work on these – the core course alignments are within the handout draft
- Core Curriculum Committee wants to look at the distribution of courses across the core
 - Are we assuring that students are getting instruction in the core?
- The next step was that the competencies and student learning outcomes, once finalized, would go to the Core Curriculum Committee for approval and then they would go to Faculty Senate
- If you think there are courses missing, email them to Alana

Forum with the Deans

- Proposing a half-day forum to be held with the Deans – around assessment
- To be able to show them the importance of assessment of student learning for the Higher Learning Commission criteria – and that that assessment of student learning be linked to planning, curricular changes and allocation of resources.
- Might be an opportunity to discuss Curriculum Mapping further with the Deans
- Deans might have some different ideas we have not heard before
- The duration of the forum will depend on the outcome and how much time it takes to get to that outcome + travel time for attendees
- Would like to show that the work we do on assessment retains students
- Really good assessment of student learning will help you decide how to change your curriculum
 - Faculty who go through the process of the UTC's Course Design Institute have students who do better in their courses after revising their courses than those before
